



On April 29, 2002, Los Angeles Sheriff's Deputy David March deployed from the Temple City Sheriff's Station and was on patrol when he effected a car stop about 1 block west of Irwindale Speedway. Seconds later, Deputy March was critically injured by gunfire prompting staff at Irwindale Speedway to clear a site for an emergency medivac of this fallen deputy. Minutes later Irwindale staff was advised that Deputy March was pronounced dead at the scene and the medivac was cancelled. Deputy March's killer fled to Mexico where he remains free from extradition.

On Saturday, April 23, 2005, Irwindale Speedway is proud to partner with Deputy March's parents to raise funds for his educational outreach to change existing extradition laws for suspects hiding in Mexico. Your attendance and donation will help the March for Justice Campaign achieve justice for victims and their families.
